Where do we play?

Our clubhouse and 5 diamonds are found at Kinsmen Park located on Pasqua St and 4th Avenue. These are home to our Rookie, Minor and Major divisions. You'll find our Junior teams playing at Pony Park located to the east of Kinsmen Arena on Elphinstone Street.

NRLL Zone

Levels

Emphasizing the spirit of Little League, rules require that every child play in every game.

Jr. & Sr. Rookie

Our "Learn to Play" divisions are the best way to teach our young ones the basics of baseball while having fun and meeting new friends. Every player receives a team t-shirt or jersey, a baseball cap and participates in a NRLL Tournament.

Minor & Major

Here is where the real game experience comes into play. These divisions divide into A & AA teams based on the level of the players. Teams start to go to tournaments and we start to groom our pitchers. They play on a 60-foot diamond with pitching distance set at 42-46 feet. Major division features a range of tournament play including the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pennsylvania.

Junior

These divisions divide into A & AA teams based on the level of the players. This division also is a little more competitive, only because that is the nature of the players in this age (13 & 14) group. They play on an 80-90 foot diamonds with a pitching distance set at 60 feet 6 inches.

Challenger Division

This division is specifically designed for children with special needs to come together as a team. We don't count outs and we don't count runs. Everybody plays. Everybody scores. Everybody wins. One game / week.

Baseball establishes the values of teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play.

Coaching

North Regina Little League offers every coach clinics that supports them in their volunteer role of teaching children baseball skills and strategy while having fun.

Evaluation

In divisions Sr. Rookie and up each player is evaluated on their batting, fielding and throwing skills and then drafted in the division that reflects their level of play.
